- 2 (a) The Board of Examiners for Speech and Language Pathologists and Audiologists
- interprets the word "testing" used in G.S. 90-293 (7) as including speech screening, but
- 4 not language screening.

- 5 (b) Licensed speech and language pathologists, registered speech-language pathology
- assistants, and unlicensed persons may perform speech screenings on the general public
- or specific populations provided that the individuals performing such screenings have
- been properly trained by a licensed speech and language pathologist in the specific
- 9 screening techniques for that screening and provided that supervision of the screening
- program is formally vested in a licensed speech and language pathologist.
- (c) The Board of Examiners for Speech and Language Pathologists and Audiologists
- interprets the word "supervision" in G. S. §90-301A to include the following elements:
  - (1) Selecting the appropriate screening instrument to be used for the target

- (2) Providing sufficient initial and refresher training in the specific screening methods
- and instruments to be used to ensure that the screeners have sufficient knowledge of the
- screening methods, understand the limitations of the screening program, and can
- demonstrate proper use of the screening materials;
- 19 (3) Assuring that records are maintained describing the training received by the
- screeners the names of attendees, the nature of any evaluation and any referral made;
  - (4) Providing sufficient evaluation of the test site to ensure that the screeners are
- following the screening protocol; and
  - (5) Reviewing samples of screening records to confirm that the screening has
- conformed to the program standards.
